PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF BALLOT TITLE

The city of Rogue River is in receipt of the following ballot title:

CAPTION:

Amends Charter; Requires City Wide Vote on all Annexations.

QUESTION:

Shall future annexations to the City require a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of Rogue River electors.

SUMMARY:

This initiative amends Chapter 1, Section 3 of the Rogue River City Charter to include the following: The City of Rogue River shall include all territory encompassed by its boundaries as they now exist or as modified as provided herein. All annexations, by whatever means, to the City of Rogue River must be approved by a prior two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the electors of the City.

The City elections official has determined that this ballot title meets the single subject requirements of Section 1 (2) (d), Article IV of the Oregon Constitution. Any elector who is dissatisfied with this ballot title may file a petition for review of the ballot title with the Circuit Court. The deadline for filing a petition for review of the ballot title with the Circuit Court is May 7th, 1996.
